Job Description:

My role at the University has evolved over a short period of time, starting as module co-ordinator and facilitator of Financial Accounting 2 to subject head of Financial Accounting, course co-ordinator and facilitator of Financial Accounting 4.

As subject head of Financial Accounting, my duties include representing the subject area on the Department's Management Committee as well as dealing with outside stakeholders such as SAICA. My duties further include managing approximately 10 staff members involved in various roles within the Department ensuring that all human resource concerns related to staff within the subject area are addressed as well as ensuring staffs' timeous delivery of high quality output. As subject head of Financial Accounting, it is my primary responsibility to ensure that the standards within the subject area as required by SAICA and other stakeholders are maintained and I therefore play a pivotal role in ensuring SAICA and SAIPA accreditation of University qualifications. In this respect, I also serve as the Department's International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) expert.

As facilitator of and module co-ordinator of Financial Accounting 4 (CTA level) it is my duty to ensure that the necessary IFRS's are taught and assessed appropriately to prepare students for a successful attempt at the SAICA Initial Test of Competence (ITC). In this respect, it is my role to ensure logical sequencing of topics, integration of topics with other subject areas (horizontal integration) and among year levels within the subject area (vertical integration), enhance efficiency and effectiveness within the subject area by ensuring that the correct policies and procedures are followed and that necessary interventions are implemented where appropriate. I also have the role of interacting and sharing resources and material with subject heads at other universities to leverage from them.
